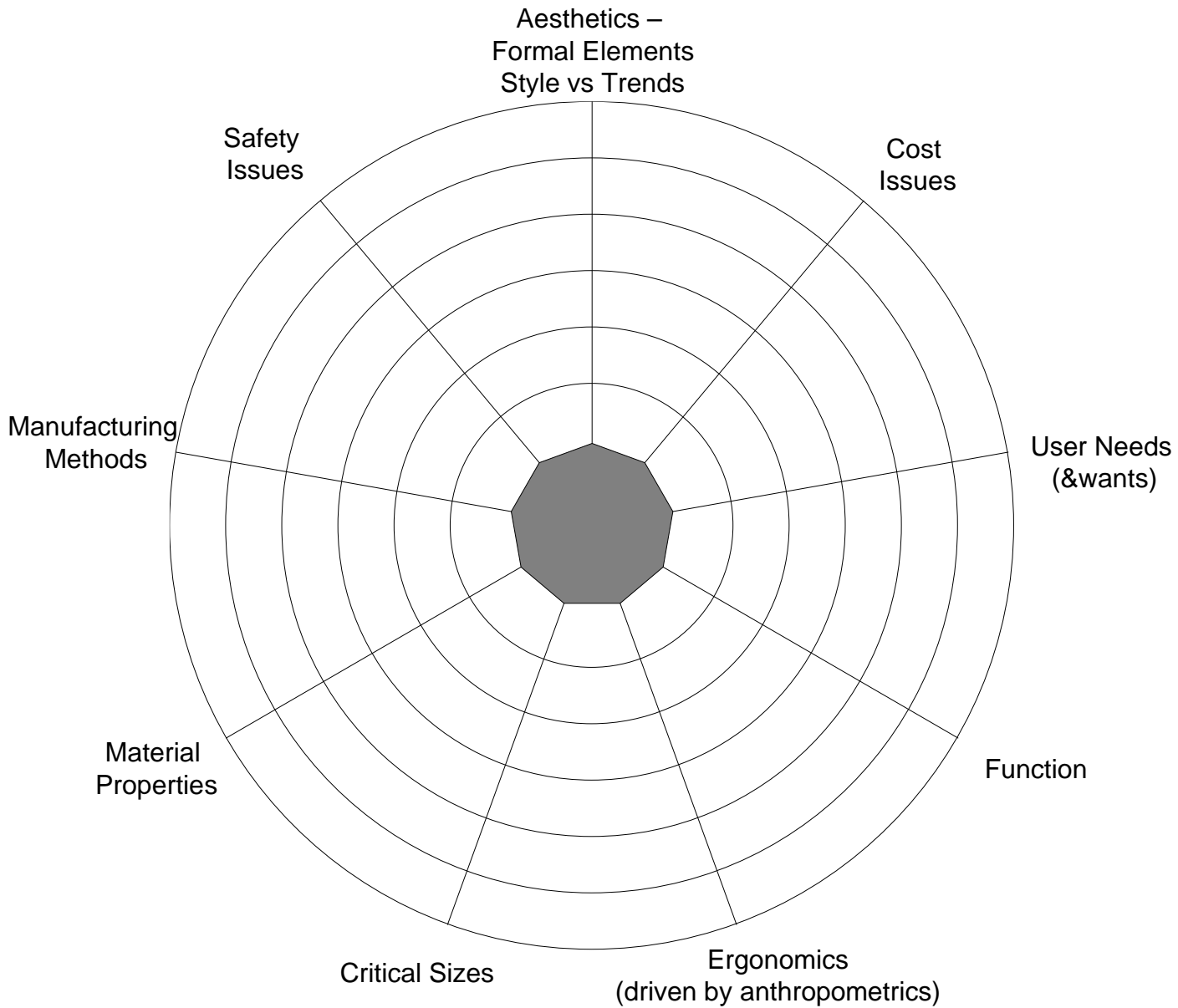


General Product Evaluation Radar Chart



Discuss, debate, question and challenge information and the nature of the task itself.

Formulate criteria to judge the quality of a product and the extent to which it meets the need, purpose and resource limits, and its impact on society..

Appreciate the conflicting demands upon designers and makers and acknowledge the balance between help and harm.

Evaluate design ideas and products by comparing them against the original design criteria and **suggest improvements**.

Make judgements about the originality and value of ideas and solutions to further their development.

Understand the need that a product is intended to serve and judge how well it meets that need.

Evaluate their design ideas and products by comparing them against the original design criteria and suggest improvements.

Evaluate your design ideas and products by comparing them against the original design criteria and suggest improvements.

Distinguish between the quality of the design and the quality of manufacture.

Modify and transform ideas, changing direction if needed, ask questions (e.g. Where is this going? Does it work? What do I do next? What makes a good ... ?).

Justify decisions made in the selection of materials and methods of making.

Discuss with the users of the product the extent to which it meets the original design criteria and refine criteria further
